**Summary:** The International Organization of Supreme Audit Institutions (INTOSAI) Working Group on Value and Benefits of Supreme Audit Institutions (WGVBS) held its 12th meeting April 1-2, 2019, in Vienna. The WGVBS, which has been chaired by SAI Mexico, since 2013, aims to develop mechanisms and tools to promote the value and benefits of Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs).

Delegates from 12 SAIs attended the meeting hosted by SAI Austria (ACA), including: Turkey, France, Hungary, India, Jamaica, Kuwait, Portugal, Senegal, South Africa, Spain, Tanzania and the United States of America.

Since the starting point of its conception, the WGVBS developed and encouraged diverse projects that aim to promote the value and benefits of Supreme Audit Institutions among the INTOSAI Community, relevant stakeholders and the general public. The current projects being worked by the WGVBS are as follows;

- The Performance Measurement Framework for Supreme Audit Institutions (SAI PMF)
- The Guideline on Effective Practices of Cooperation between SAIs, the Legislature, the Judiciary, and the Executive
- Risk Identification Process in the Public Sector
- Task Force on Audits Quality Control
